This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 458 dated 11.11.2016 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Rai.

The trial Court had declined the bail application of the petitioner vide order dated 13.12.2019 (Annexure P-2). Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to the order dated 07.12.2017 (Annexure P-4) whereby petitioner therein i.e. Raja Mohammad with similar allegations had been granted regular bail.

Learned counsel for the State has informed that petitioner is in custody since 30.08.2019 as per the information given by SI Krishan Kumar. Keeping in view that regular bail has been granted to one Raja Mohammad vide order dated 07.12.2017 (Annexure P-4) having similar allegations and keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time but without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the present petition is allowed.

Petitioner Narender Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on

furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- a. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- b. In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- c. He shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
