**HARI PAL VERMA, J. (Oral)**

The petitioner has filed this criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.PC for his premature release in FIR No.295 dated 14.05.2011 under Sections 294, 506, 376 and 120-B IPC as well as Sections 67(a,b,c) and 68 of the Information Technology Act, 2000 registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that for the relief claimed in the present petition the petitioner has already approached the Superintendent, District Jail, Karnal on 27.11.2019 by way of representation (Annexure P-1) submitted by Jitender Singh brother of the petitioner so as to release the petitioner as he has already undergone six years of sentence of imprisonment.

He further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.2 i.e. the Jail Superintendent, District Prison, Karnal to take a final decision on the aforesaid representation (Annexure P-1).

On asking of this Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to take note of the contents of representation (Annexure P-1) and to take a final decision on the same within two months from today.
