KOMAL DEVI AND ANR V/S STATE OF HARYANA AND ORS

The petitioners, having performed marriage against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6, had filed CRM-M-46327-2018 under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty from danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 and further direction to respondent No.3 not to harass and interfere in their peaceful married life.

The above-said petition was disposed of by Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 29.10.2018. The concluding para of order dated 29.10.2018 is reproduced as under:-

“In terms of the Supreme Court observation, the official respondents are directed to examine the representation dated 23.10.2018 of the petitioners and to give necessary protection while appreciating the fact that there is threat to their life. Petitioners are present in Court. Second petitioner undertakes to deposit a sum of ₹50,000/- in the form of F.D.R. In the Nationalized Bank for a period of 3 years in the name of first petitioner – Komal Devi within a period of 3 months from today. Second petitioner is directed to deposit copy of the F.D.R. in the Registry of this Court within a period of 3 months from today. In case he fails to do so, Registry is directed to list this matter on 25.03.2018. This order shall not validate the marriage of the petitioners.”

On failure on the part of petitioner No.2 to deposit copy of the F.D.R. in the Registry, the Registry has listed the matter.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has filed copy of the F.D.R. Dated 08.08.2019 for amount of Rs.50,000/- for one year in the name of petitioner No.1 in the Court today which is taken on record. However, the above-said F.D.R. Shall be liable to be renewed for further period of two years in compliance with order dated 29.10.2018.

In view of the subsequent compliance, no further action is required to be taken on the present IOIN which is disposed of accordingly.

A copy of this order be sent to the concerned Branch Manager for renewal of the F.D.R. For further period of two years.
