The present petition has been filed under section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 1129 dated 14.09.2019 under section 174-A, IPC, 1860.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court on 08.01.2020, the petitioner already joined the investigations and has cooperated with the police and therefore, has prayed for grant of anticipatory bail in the present case.

In the present case, the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person under section 174A of Indian Penal Code and thereafter, he had surrendered before the learned trial Court on 14.10.2019 and he was granted bail on the same day itself. However, since he was declared as a PO and FIR No. 1126 dated 14.09.2019 was lodged against him under section 174A, IPC which was listed against him. He has filed present petition for the grant of anticipatory bail in the present case on the

ground that he has already surrendered before the trial Court and is ready to join the investigations.

Learned counsel for the State states that in pursuance of the orders passed by this Court on 08.01.2020, the petitioner has already joined the investigations and is fully cooperating with the Investigating Officer. He has further submitted on instructions from ASI Ram Kumar that he is no more required for custodial investigation.

In view of the stand taken by the State counsel, he is no more required for the investigations, the present petition is allowed. Order dated 08.01.2020 passed by this Court is hereby, made absolute.
