Petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to protect their life and liberty and not to interfere in their married life at the instance of respondent Nos.5 to 7.

On 26.12.2019, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In response to the said order, status report by way of affidavit of Jaswant Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Samana on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed in Court today. As per this reply, it is mentioned that during enquiry, statements of the petitioners (Annexures R-1 and R-2) were recorded, wherein they stated that they are living peacefully at Village Badshapur Kaleki, Tehsil Samana, District Patiala and that they have neither any danger from their parents nor

they want to take any action on the petition filed by them.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in this petition, which is rendered infructuous.
