Petitioners have filed this writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect their life and liberty from respondent Nos.4 and 5 as they have solemnized marriage on 21.12.2019 against their wishes.

On 27.12.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Ms. Ashima Mor, APP, U.T.Chandigarh is directed to verify the facts as stated in the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to furnish three copies of the petition to Learned counsel for the State during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 6.1.2020.”

In compliance of the order dated 27.12.2019, learned APP, U.T.Chandigarh has produced the joint statement of respondent Nos.4 and 5

and submits that they are not opposed to the alleged marriage of the petitioners. A copy of the statement has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press this petition and prays for withdrawal of the same.
