Petitioners have filed this writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect their life and liberty from respondent Nos.4 and 5 as they have solemnized marriage on 23.12.2019 against their wishes.

On 26.12.2019, State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat.

Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Rajesh Kumar PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police Barnala on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Copy thereof has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners. In the reply, it is mentioned that they have no objection to the alleged marriage performed by the petitioners. The joint statement of the respondent Nos.4 and 5 is also appended as Annexure R-1.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners states that nothing survives in the present petition for adjudication, as the petition is rendered infructuous.
