The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.335 dated 20.10.2019 under Sections 376 and 323 IPC registered at Police Station Talwani Sabo, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and in fact the present FIR has been registered in retaliation to FIR No.138 dated 19.05.2019 registered by the petitioner under Sections 307, 323, 324, 452, 354, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of SC/ST Act and Section 25 of Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Sadhu Ram submits that non-bailable warrants have been issued against the petitioner for 11.02.2020. Besides, there are serious allegations against the petitioner for offence punishable under Section 376 IPC.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, no ground is made

out for grant of anticipatory bail as the allegations levelled against the petitioner are very serious. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
