Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.533 dated 16.07.2019 registered under Sections 406 & 420 IPC, registered at Police Station City Bhiwani, District Bhiwani, Haryana.

On 01.01.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has not been named in the FIR. Allegations are against Ajay s/o Tejbir in respect of receiving an amount of Rs. 90,000/- in two installments through phone pay transactions on 17th April 2019 and 23rd April 2019. Petitioner has been implicated on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused Ajay. Petitioner is not privy to any

assurance for getting the job for the complainant. Recovery of the amount has already been made from father of Ajay.

Notice of motion for 27.02.2020.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 16.01.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, on his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Hitender Singh admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of above, interim order dated 01.01.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when directed to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
