Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.34 dated 22.05.2019 registered under Sections 354/323/354-B IPC (later on offence U/s 295-A IPC deleted vide rapat No.30 dated 14.06.2019) at Police Station Bajakhana, District Faridkot.

On 01.01.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that tearing of the shirt of the complainant in the scuffle between the petitioner and one Ramjan Mohammad when she intervened whether would attract the ingredients of offence under Section 354/354-B IPC, is debatable, particularly in the view of the compromise between the parties at one point of time and the investigation done by

the police, deleting the offence under Section 295-A IPC. Petitioner has also received number of injuries on his person.

Notice of motion for 24.02.2020.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 16.01.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, on his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balraj Singh admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of above, interim order dated 01.01.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when directed to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
