Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.112 dated 27.10.2019 registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 506 & 34 IPC at P.S. Dera Baba Nanak, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

In view of order of even date, passed in CRM-M No.55705 of 2019, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 02.03.2020 and in the event of his arrest, he shall be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Agency subject to the following conditions as envisaged under

Section 438(2) Cr.P.C:-

- i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation before the Investigating Officer as and when required;
- ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- iii) that the petitioner shall not leave the country, without prior permission of the Court and shall surrender his passport, if any.

Petition stands disposed of.
