The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.62 dated 05.05.2019 registered under Sections 379, 188 IPC and 81(5) of the Haryana Minor Mineral Concession, Stocking, Transportation of Minerals and Prevention of Illegal Mining Rule, 2012 at Police Station Buria, District Yamuna Nagar.

The operative part of the order dated 08.01.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Counsel for the petitioner relies upon the orders dated 04.11.2019 and 17.12.2019 passed in CRM-M Nos.44414, 40006 and 47776 of 2019, vide which the co-accused of the petitioner namely Danish, Balinder Singh and Mohammad Najim, have been granted the concession of anticipatory bail...”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 08.01.2020, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 08.01.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
