SUVIR SEHGAL J. (ORAL)

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.241, dated 01.11.2019 registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur under Sections 323, 324, 341, 379-B, 148, 149 and 120-B of IPC, 1860 and Sections 307 and 326 of IPC added vide order dated 13.01.2020.

Vide order dated 13.01.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case and the order dated 13.01.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
