The petitioner filed present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for getting the detenues named in para No.4 of the petition released from illegal custody of respondents No. 4 to 6 by appointment of a warrant officer.

Vide order dated 31.12.2019, Registry was directed to appoint a Warrant Officer to visit the place(s) as pointed out by the petitioner and search for the aforesaid detenues and in case they are found to be in illegal custody of the private respondents, get them released forthwith.

The Warrant Officer has submitted his report dated 03.01.2019 that the persons named in para no. 4 of the petition had not been illegally detained and on expression of their desire that they did not want to work in the brick kiln in question they were allowed to leave the premises of the brick kiln alongwith their belongings.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has acknowledged this factual position and submits that no further action is required to be taken in the present habeas corpus petition.

In these facts and circumstances, the habeas corpus petition is disposed of as no further action is required to be taken on the same.
