1. The petitioner is seeking appointment of an arbitrator under Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act with respect to its claims to the tune of Rs.1,00,13,862/- against the respondent.
2. The arbitration agreement between the parties is contained in clause 26.4 of the agreement dated 23rd March, 2017. The respondent invoked the arbitration on 15th May, 2019. The arbitration agreement and the invocation notice are not disputed.
