It is seen from the record that two applications, one seeking parole and the other seeking exemption, have both been numbered Crl. M. A. No. 5773/2020 by the Registry. Let this be corrected.

2. At the outset, Mr. Ayush Srivastava, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that during pendency of the writ petition seeking parole, the petitioner was granted parole on an interim basis by order dated 08.04.2020.
