2. Learned counsel for the respondent has no objection, and he points out, in fact, that orders stand reserved by the learned sole arbitrator.

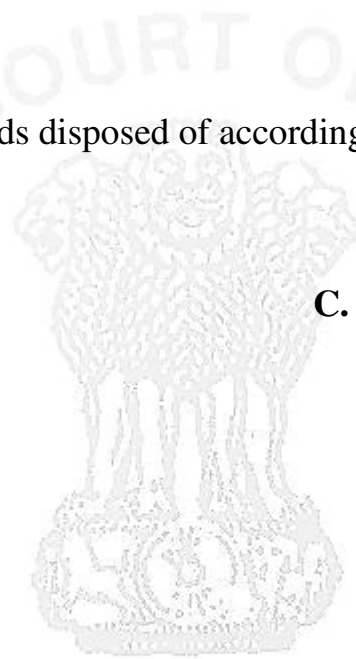
