Petitioner, who is undergoing sentence of rigorous imprisonment of ten years in FIR No. 107/2011, registered at police station Begumpur, Delhi for committing offences under Sections 392/397/411/482/34 IPC, was granted four weeks' parole on 2nd December, 2019 by this Court. Vide this petition, petitioner is seeking extension of parole for three months to take care of his wife and newly born son. Petitioner's parole is expiring on 8th January, 2020.
