The applicant seeks grant of bail in terms of Section 439 of the Cr.PC, 1973 submitting *inter alia* to the effect that the applicant has been incarcerated for about six months now and he has been falsely implicated in the instant case and no useful purpose would be served by the continuation of the incarceration of the applicant.

The status report dated 11.02.2020 is on the record as submitted by the State indicating to the effect that there are 14 stab injuries inflicted by the applicant on the complainant apart from the stab injuries also inflicted on the minor child born of the wedlock between the applicant and complainant. The same submission is also submitted through the MLC, copy of which has been placed on record.

In the circumstances, though a submission is made on behalf of the applicant to the effect that the injuries sustained by the complainant/ injured, the wife of the applicant and the minor child of

the applicant are simple injuries, the same does not suffice to grant the prayer made by the applicant seeking the grant of bail.

The application is declined.
