2. The prayers in the present petition stand covered by the judgment of this Court in *Dev Sharma v. Indo-Tibetan Border Police (2019) 174 DRJ 98 (DB)*, as further clarified by an order dated 4<sup>th</sup> February, 2019 in W.P.(C) 695/2019 (*Ram Chander Kasania v. Union of India*).

3. The Respondents issued a Circular dated 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2019 by way of

implementation of the said judgments, which limited the relief granted in *Dev Sharma (supra)* only to the 29 Petitioners in that case. However, this Court, by way of its order dated 19<sup>th</sup> December, 2019 in W.P.(C) 13195/2019 (*Bharat Singh v. Union of India*), set aside the aforesaid stipulation, and extended the benefit of *Dev Sharma (supra)* to all similarly placed individuals.

4. The Court now directs the Respondents to issue the necessary orders in terms of *Bharat Singh (supra)* within 12 weeks from today.

5. The petition is disposed of.
