It is seen that in handwritten responses not on one occasion but on 3 occasions i.e. 12th January, 2018, 25th June, 2018 and finally on 25th July, 2018 the Petitioner ticked the box titled 'No' to the specific query whether any FIR has been lodged and a case has been pending against him.
