Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

The applications are disposed of accordingly.

CM APPL.19978/2020/2020 (Exemption)

The present application under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 has been filed on behalf of the applicant/respondents seeking exemption from filing duly affirmed affidavits in support of the accompanying review petition and to pay the requisite court fees.

For the reasons stated in the application and in view of the present prevailing situation, the same is allowed. The applicant/respondents are allowed to file the duly signed and affirmed affidavits within a period of

one week from the date of resumption of regular functioning of the Court. Further, the applicant/respondents are allowed to file the requisite court fee within a period of one week from today.

With the above directions, the present application is disposed of.

CM APPL.19973/2020 (Condonation of Delay)
