3. Vide the present petition, petitioners seeks direction thereby for quashing of FIR No. 66/2018 dated 19.03.2018, registered at Police Station Dwarka South and all other proceedings arising therefrom.
4. Notice issued.
5. Notice is accepted by learned APP for State and respondent no.2 and with the consent of counsel for parties, the present petition is taken up for final disposal.

6. The present petition is filed on the ground that parties have settled their disputes and respondent no. 2 has no objection if the present petition is allowed.

7. Respondent no. 2 is personally present in Court and she has been identified by SI Vikas /IO and submits that matter has been settled and she does not wish to prosecute the matter any further.

8. Petitioners and respondent no.2 have entered into an amicable settlement and settled all their disputes amicably before Village Panchayat on 15.08.2019.

9. Taking into account the aforesaid facts, this Court is inclined to quash FIR as no useful purpose would be served in prosecuting petitioners any further.

10. For the reasons afore-recorded, FIR No. 66/2018 dated 19.03.2018, registered at Police Station Dwarka South consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

11. The petition is, accordingly, allowed and disposed of.
