3. The limited grievance of the petitioner is that while the Letter of Intent (LOI) was issued on 19.9.2018 and a response qua the same was submitted by it on 5.2.2019, there has been no further movement in the matter.
3. Thus, the captioned writ petition is disposed with a direction to the concerned regional committee i.e. NRC/WRC to dispose of the petitioner's application for grant of recognition qua D.El.Ed. course at the earliest.

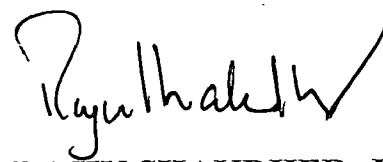
