Vide the present petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of the FIR No.134/2018, PS Punjabi Bagh under Sections 279/337 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 in terms of settlement stated to be arrived at at the Delhi Mediation Centre, THC on 04.09.2019 in MACT No.793/2018 and MACT No.794/2018.
