The grievance of the petitioners is that two proceedings, namely, Appeal No.97/DC/NW/2014 titled as 'Gaon Sabha Nizampur Vs. Balwan Singh & Ors.' and Remand Proceedings vide Case No.470/DC/NW/2014 titled as 'Suo-Moto Vs. Balwan Singh' are pending before the Deputy Commissioner for the last three years.
