1. Exemption is allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

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3. The petitioner has filed the present petition, *inter alia*, praying that the petitioner be released on parole in connection with FIR No. 289/2006, under Sections 302/34 of the IPC, registered with PS Sarai Rohilla.
