This is a petition for quashing of the FIR No. 368/2018 P. S. Tilak Nagar under Section 354D/341/506 Indian Penal Code, 1860. It is stated the matter has been amicably settled between the parties vide the settlement agreement dated 17.02.2020. It is further stated both the petitioner and respondent no.2 were good friends but later some mis-understanding led to filing of the said FIR and since now both the parties have agreed and have amicably settled their dispute and differences, the FIR be quashed.
