1. In view of the clarification given on the last date, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the subsequent bail application being BAIL APPLN 1029/2020. The same is dismissed as withdrawn.
2. Learned APP for the State submits that a fresh Status Report has been placed on record in BAIL APPLN 1029/2020. The Registry shall place a copy of same in records of the present bail application.
