1. It is admitted that, out of 69 prosecution witnesses, only 19 have been examined till date.
2. After some arguments, Mr. R.N.Sharma, learned counsel for the applicant submits, on instructions, that, for the present, he would be satisfied if the application is disposed of with a direction to the learned trial court, as well as the IO, to ensure that recording of evidence of the remaining public witnesses – those who are non-official witnesses – is concluded within six months from today.
3. The present application is disposed of with the aforesaid direction.

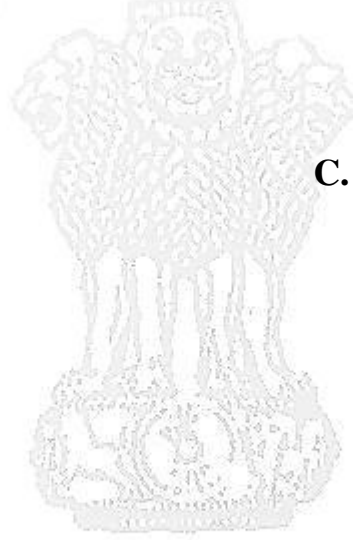
