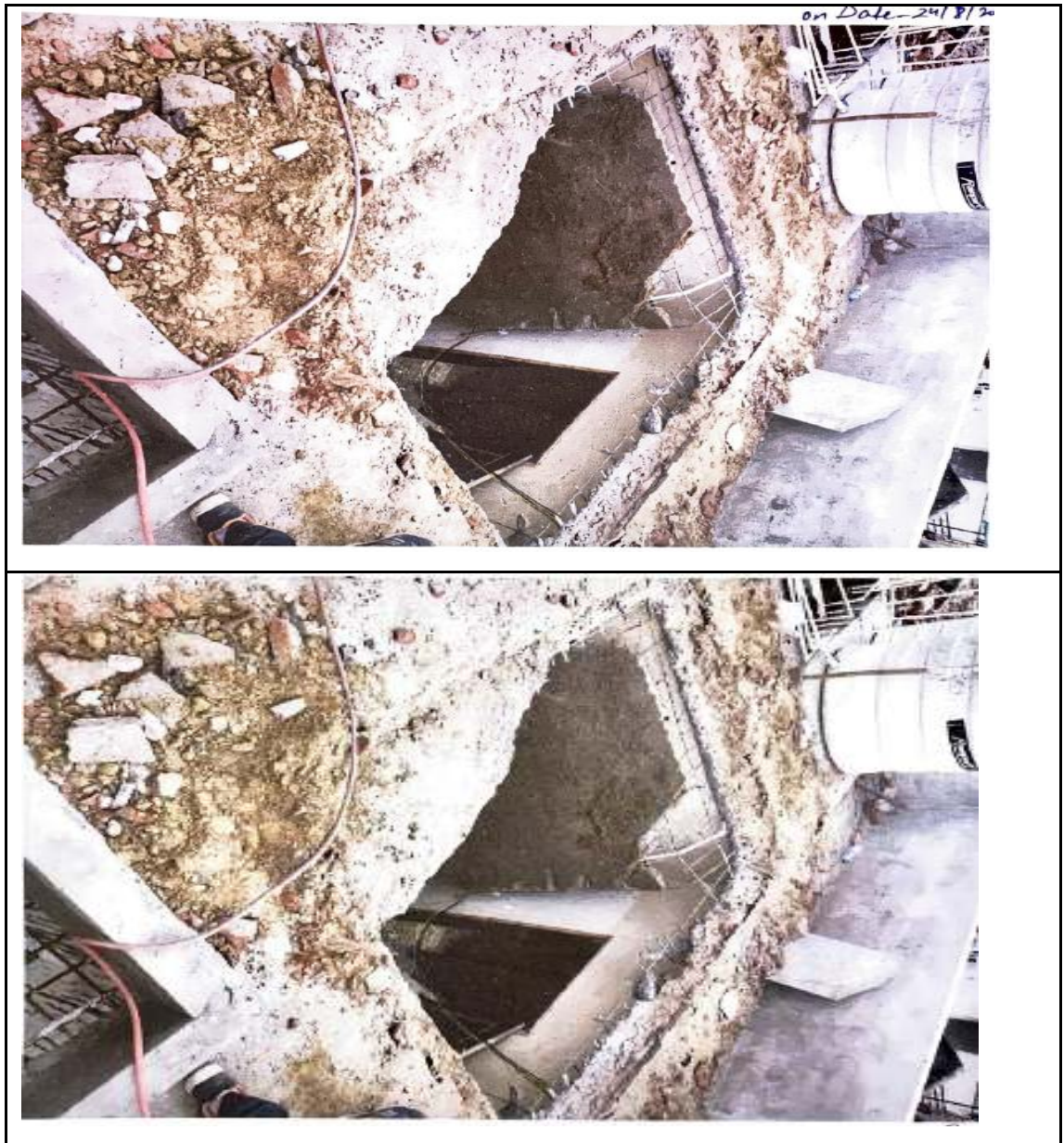
1. The hearing was conducted through video conferencing.
