also the parole was granted vide order dated 19.02.2019 in W.P.(CrI.) 170/2019 and again he filed a W.P.(CrI.) 89/2020 which was allowed on 21.05.2020.

7. However he has enjoyed the parole but as per learned ASC he has not surrendered in time and had sought extension from this Court but such request was disallowed. The petitioner has not surrendered till date and presently is in Jabalpur. It is alleged he is BC of the Punjabi Bagh Police Station.

8. Considering the facts this Court is not inclined to give any indulgence.

9. In the circumstances the petition stands dismissed.
