It is an application seeking exemption from filing attested affidavit. Taking note of the prevailing circumstances on account of Covid-19 pandemic, the application is granted with the stipulation that the attested affidavit shall be filed within 07 days of the resumption of the regular functioning of the Court. Application stands disposed of accordingly.

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During the course of hearing, Mr. Khatri, ld. counsel for the applicant submits that on account of rare disease of multiple myeloma for which the applicant is having treatment from the medical oncology department of

AIIMS, she was unable to surrender within the time for which she was admitted to interim bail.
