Mr. Tewari, learned counsel for the petitioners fairly states that in view of the recent Guidelines dated 29.8.2020, issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs, UOI, Unlockdown-4 has been implemented and all embargo on intra-State and inter-State travel has been lifted. Therefore, he does not wish to press present petition wherein, a limited relief was sought for issuing directions to the respondents not to restrain persons, who wish to undergo an RT-PCR test for COVID-19 infection for inter-State travel.
