1. This is a petition under Section 29(A)(4) & (5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, for extension of time available with the learned sole arbitrator, to conclude the proceedings and render the award, in the arbitration relating to the disputes between the petitioner and the respondent.
2. It is reported that the time available with the learned sole arbitrator has expired on 19th June, 2020.
