1. This writ petition is filed by the petitioners seeking appropriate direction to respondent No. 1 to forthwith decide all the representations made by the petitioners.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners pointed out to Section 4(2) of the Indian Veterinary Council Act, 1984 to plead that the representations have been filed under the statutory provisions. It is pleaded that these representations pertain to the elections that had taken place to the said Indian Veterinary Council of India that were held on 20.08.2020 to 22.08.2020 results of which were declared on 24.08.2020.
