Faced with the objection of the learned counsel for the respondents that an alternate efficacious remedy in the form of an appeal is available to the petitioners against the Impugned Order dated 01.08.2019, the learned counsel for the petitioners prays for leave to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail of such appellate remedy.
