1. The prayers in the present petition stand covered by the decisions dated 9<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 in W.P.(C) No. 10026/2016 (*Govind Kumar Srivastava v. Union of India*); dated 11<sup>th</sup> December, 2019 in W.P.(C) No. 5642/2019 (*Mohammad Israr Khan v. Union of India*) and dated 15<sup>th</sup> January 2020 in W.P. (C) 9524 of 2019 (*Rakesh Kumar v. Union of India*).

2. Accordingly, a direction is issued to the Respondents to grant the Petitioner *pro rata* pension from the date that he was discharged from the service, with arrears being paid to the Petitioner not later than 12 weeks from today, failing which the Respondent would be liable to pay simple interest at the rate of 6% per annum on the said sum for the period of delay.

3. The petition is disposed of in the above terms.
