1. Petitioner is seeking parole for a period of three months in order to maintain social ties with family and society. As per nominal roll, the conduct of the petitioner is satisfactory, however, it is submitted by learned ASC for the State that the petitioner may not be released before 23.1.2020 as on that date the other co-accused has to surrender.

2.
