1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. Application is disposed of.

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3. Vide the present petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 191/2016 dated 04.08.2016 registered at Police Station Civil Lines and consequent proceedings arising therefrom.
4. Notice issued.

5. Notice is accepted by learned APP for the State and counsel for the respondent no.2 and with the consent of the counsel for the parties, the present petition is taken up for final disposal.

6. The petitioner no.1 and respondent no.2 got married on 21.04.2015 as per Hindu rites and rituals. Due to extreme incompatibilities between the petitioners and respondent no.2, they started living separately from 07.06.2017.

7. The petitioners and respondent no.2 with the intervention of their well wishers and relatives have entered into an amicable settlement before the Delhi Mediation Centre, Tis Hazari Courts vide settlement deed dated 21.08.2018 and settled all their disputes amicably.

8. The complainant is present in person with her counsel and has been identified by WSI Renu of Police Station Civil Lines and submits that matter has been settled and she does not wish to prosecute the matter any further.

9. Taking into account the aforesaid facts, this Court is inclined to quash the FIR as no useful purpose would be served in prosecuting the petitioners any further.

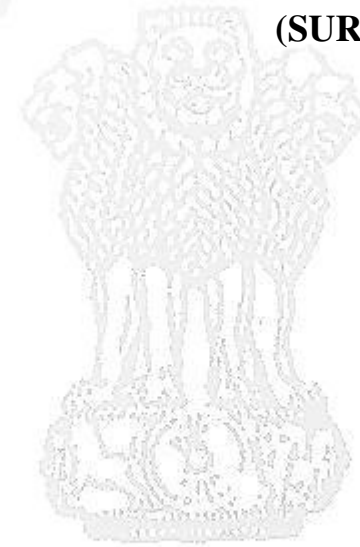
