1. This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. filed on behalf of the petitioner seeking condonation of delay in re-filing the present petition.
2. For the reasons stated in the application, the delay in re-filing the petition is condoned.
3. Application stands disposed of.

CRL.M.C. 5817/2019 and Crl.M.A.No.40413/2019 (stay)

1. After some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition.
