1. The substantive prayers made in the petition are as follows:

“a. Issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, Order or Directions for processing the application bearing Application ID FR-NRC-2021-07101022 of the Petitioner institution seeking recognition for the ITEP course; and/or

b. Issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, Order or Directions for NOTE re-accept the processing fee or any other details as desired; and/or...”

2. Counsel for the parties inform me that the issue raised in the instant petition is covered by the decision of this Court rendered on 8.1.2020 in a batch of writ petitions, the lead case being W.P.(C) No.12307/2019 titled ***Shri Vinayak Mahavidyalay vs. National Council for Teacher Education and Anr.***
