Vide this petition, transfer of case CC No. 710/1/2019, titled as “*Anil Kapoor Vs. Sarabjit Singh*”, pending before the Court of Ms.Ekta Gauba, ACMM (NW), Rohini District Courts, Delhi to the court of Sh. Sachin Gupta, MM, Rohini District Courts, Delhi where the other case being CC No. 109/1/10, titled as *S. Sarabjit Singh & Ors. S. Malkit Singh & Ors.* ’ is pending, is sought.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has opposed this petition on the ground that parties to both the complaints are different and facts of the case have no bearing on each other.

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Learned counsel for petitioner submits that though the parties to the complaints are different but the both the complaints pertain to one property and, therefore, adjudication of one case will have a strong bearing on another and, therefore, in the interest of justice, both these matters should be tried by one court.

Heard.

Sarabjit Singh*”, pending before the Court of Ms. Ekta Gauba, ACMM (NW), Rohini District Courts, Delhi to the court of Sh. Sachin Gupta, MM, Rohini District Courts, Delhi, for hearing along with CC No. 109/1/10, titled as *S. Sarabjit Singh & Ors. S. Malkit Singh & Ors.*

Let a copy of this order be sent to the concerned trial courts for compliance.

The petition stands disposed of with aforesaid directions.
