4. In terms of the settlement, name of Master Divyansh is deleted from the array of parties in both the petitions on account of his attaining the age of majority and amended memo of parties, filed along with the present applications, are taken on record.
5. The above-noted petitions are disposed of. Miscellaneous applications is disposed of as infructuous.
6. Date fixed in the matter, i.e. 03.04.2020 is hereby cancelled.
7. The above applications stand disposed of in the above terms.
