2. The applicant will file the requisite affidavits within two weeks of the normal functioning of the Court being restored.

3. This is an application filed by the decree holder(DH) seeking permission to withdraw the present enforcement petition, in view of the settlement arrived at between the parties on 14.08.2020.
4. Issue notice. Learned counsel for the respondent accepts notice and confirms the fact that the parties have entered into a settlement on

5. In view of the aforesaid, the application is allowed, and the enforcement petition stands dismissed as not pressed. The registry is directed to return the bank guarantee dated 15.11.2018 furnished by the DH.
