1. Learned counsel for the petitioner admitted that the judgment has already been passed in the matter by the Trial Court and the petitioner has already been convicted by the Trial Court and the appeal is pending before the Appellate Court.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent No.2 submitted that in view of the aforesaid facts, the present petition has become infructuous and the petitioner can raise all the contentions before the Appellate Court in accordance with law.
