CM APPL.5161/2020 (for condonation of delay in re-filing)

1. For the reasons stated in the application, the application is allowed. The delay in re-filing the application is condoned.

2. Application is disposed of.

CM APPL.5160/2020 (for withdrawal)

1. By this application, petitioner submits that a settlement has taken place between the parties and accordingly, he seeks leave to withdraw the revision petition. Learned counsel for the respondent confirms the same.

2. In view of the above, the application is allowed.

4. Next date of 21.07.2020 is cancelled.

RC.REV. 635/2018

1. Learned counsel for the parties submit that the parties have entered into a settlement dated 18.01.2020.
