Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Triloki Singh holding brief of Sri V.C. Tripathi, learned counsel for the respondents.

The daughter of the petitioner Sangeeta Kumari was working as Constable in Railway Protection Force. During her service period, she died on 23.10.2016. After her death family pension was being paid to the mother of Sangeeta Kumari. Mother of late Sangeeta Kumari also died on 22.10.2017. After the death of mother, the petitioner is entitled to get family pension. The petitioner in this respect has submitted a representation to the respondent no.1-Senior Additional Security Commissioner, R.P.F (Eastern RPF), U.P., Lucknow.

Grievance of the petitioner is that neither the family pension has been paid to the petitioner nor his representation has been considered by the authority concerned.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that no useful purpose would be served in keeping the writ petition pending, and an appropriate direction be issued to respondent no.1 to consider the grievance of the petitioner.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, without going into merits of the case and with the consent of the parties, the writ petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to file a fresh representation before the respondent no.1-Senior Additional Security Commissioner, R.P.F (Eastern RPF), U.P., Lucknow, raising all his grievances within a period of three weeks from today. In case any such representation is filed, the respondent no.1 shall consider and decide the same by a reasoned and speaking order within a period of four months thereafter.

With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition is ***disposed of***.
