Heard Sri Nikhil Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Vivek Kumar Rai, learned counsel appearing for the respondents.

The petitioner who appeared for a selection examination to the post of Junior Engineer, conducted by the Railway Recruitment Board has passed the required computer based test and his document verification has also been undertaken, but his medical examination is held up. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has come up seeking relief in terms that a mandamus be issued to the respondent to issue a medical examination memo for the petitioner's medical examination, and, thereafter, to issue an appointment letter to him. It is submitted by the petitioner that his medical examination has been held. This petition, therefore, has been rendered infructuous and may be dismissed as such.

It is, accordingly, **dismissed** as infructuous.
