ORAL ORDER

2 05-07-2021 Heard the parties in virtual court proceeding.

Let the defect(s) be removed within four weeks after start of the physical court.

The petitioners are languishing in custody for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 302, 201 of the I.P.C.

Submission is that only material against the petitioners and others is of suspicion to be involved in the murder.

Learned counsel for the informant as well as State submits that during investigation it has come that the petitioners and others were involved in the conspiracy which resulted in



murder of two persons for the reason that old dispute was there between the parties for lane and the accused persons had threatened in the past.

Considering lack of material against the petitioners for further detention as under trial prisoners, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with Rajgir P.S. Case No. 197 of 2020, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.

(c) The petitioners shall not leave the country without permission of the trial Court.
